

**MINUTES OF WALLERAWANG QUARRY COMMUNITY CONSULTATIVE COMMITTEE
HELD AT THE QUARRY, GREAT WESTERN HIGHWAY WALLERAWANG ON 10th April
2018**

MINUTES OF PREVIOUS Minutes of the previous meeting held 13th December 2017 were approved as a true and correct record.

MEETING:

BUSINESS ARISING FROM LAST MINUTES: Clearing of land to the North East is yet to commence. As per last meeting, notification of clearing will be considered.

It was agreed that appointment of additional members to the committee is not necessary.

QUARRY OPERATIONS: Walker Quarries are looking into supplying select fill to Energy Australia.

New Plant Equipment has been received and development of the quarry is continuing.

INDEPENDENT ENVIRONMENTAL AUDIT: An audit will commence on Thursday 12th April 2018 which will be conducted by SLR.

BIODIVERSITY: Walker Quarries are obliged to apply for credits to cover clearing of the new stockpile area.

UPDATE MINE REHAB PLAN: MOP has been completed and lodged with NSW Department of Planning.

EPA VISIT: EPA are satisfied that their compliance conditions and recommendations are being met.
Areas have been cleaned to ensure no dirty water is going into the dams. Walker Quarries are investigating a new flocculant that will help settle any fines and keep the water clean in case of any discharge.

Sue Graves was given a site inspection a few weeks ago and is very impressed with the tidiness of the quarry.

EXTENSION DEVELOPMENT APPROVAL: The present development approval expires in the middle of 2019. A modification to the present approval or a new EIS will be prepared. However, the matter would be subject to Department of Planning and Environment requirements.

COMPLAINTS REGISTER:

No complaints have been received since last meeting.

GENERAL BUSINESS:

Western Stockpile Area - Has been completed. Hydro Mulch has been sprayed on bunds and Native Trees have been planted.

Appointment of Fire Officer - Mr Ross Brownlow has been appointed as Fire Officer for Walker Quarries.

Members of the CCC are invited for a site inspection. Ray Sharwood will contact interested members with a date.

Approval from Lithgow Council for the new administration building has been received and work should commence over the coming weeks.
